

The Gender Clinic is part of Monash Health, which is the largest public health service in Melbourne, Australia. The Gender Clinic is a state wide service that accepts referrals for individuals who are aged 17 and above and reside in the state of Victoria. The Gender Clinic provides assessment and individualised client centred care for trans, gender diverse and non-binary people with the aim of improving their health and well-being. A referral from a medical practitioner (GP or medical specialist) is required.

How to make a referral (for GP's/medical specialists):

Please include the following patient information in your referral letter:

- Patient's preferred title/name/pronoun
 - Name on Medicare card, address and DOB
 - Medicare Number
 - Patient's contact details (phone number and e-mail)
 - Interpreter needed? If yes, for which language?
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- Reason for referral
 - Diagnostic impression. Include a brief assessment of current functioning and risk issues.
 - Was the patient recently in contact with mental health services?

Once you've emailed your referral letter to the Gender Clinic at genderclinic@monashhealth.org you will receive a confirmation e-mail. We will then contact your patient.

After completion of the assessment (which may take 3-6 months) we will send a letter to inform you about the assessment outcome.
