

Monash Health

Monash Health provides comprehensive health care services to people in the south-eastern suburbs of metropolitan Melbourne including the cities of Bayside, Cardinia, Casey, Greater Dandenong, Kingston and Monash. Services are provided through a number of hospitals and community health services to a population of almost 900,000 people.

The Monash Health Wellness and Recovery Centre (WRC) Eating Disorder Service is a specialist service operating across Monash Health Campuses. Services include:

- * Adults (18-65yo) Inpatient Treatment
- * Adults (18-65yo) Outpatient Treatment
- * Butterfly Day Program (12-24yo)

The service offers comprehensive Eating Disorder assessment, diagnosis and evidence-based treatment to individuals affected by Anorexia Nervosa, Bulimia Nervosa, Binge eating Disorder, and Other Specified Feeding & Eating Disorder (OSFED)

For each client, staff will work to establish a comprehensive care team around the individual, and to facilitate regular communication between these care team members to promote co-ordinated, holistic care.

Adult Inpatient Treatment (18-65yrs)

A structured, inpatient program operating from a specialised Eating Disorder Unit on West 4, Dandenong Hospital.

- Medical monitoring and supervision
- Nutritional rehabilitation
- Weight restoration
- Supportive therapies
- Inhibition of eating disordered behaviours
- Meal supervision
- Structured daily activities

Adult Outpatient Treatment (18-65yrs)

A Specialist Outpatient Clinic Operating from Monash Hospital Clayton

- Nutritional management
- Co-ordinated case management
- Individual therapy
- Family therapy
- Education consultation and support
- Family Meal Support Therapy
- Advocacy
- Co-ordination of inpatient admission, if required

Butterfly Day Program (12-24yrs)

An intensive 12 week day program that is based at Chadstone that offers:

- Weight restoration and maintenance
- Nutritional management
- Normalisation of eating behaviour/beliefs
- Staff supported meal supervision
- Family involvement
- Group Therapy
- Individual key support work

Staff

The Wellness and Recovery Centre eating disorder program is delivered by an experienced, multidisciplinary team of staff including:

- Consultant Psychiatrist
- Nurse Practitioner
- Psychologists
- Social Worker
- Dietician

Where a participant has an established therapeutic relationship with an external treatment provider (e.g. private psychiatrist), WRC staff will communicate regularly with this provider to facilitate optimal treatment outcomes.

Eligibility Criteria

Patients wishing to access the Wellness and Recovery Centre must fulfil the following criteria:

- Live in the Southern Metropolitan Region of Victoria
- Present with a diagnosis, or behaviour consistent with a diagnosis of, Anorexia Nervosa, Bulimia Nervosa, or OSFED
- Have or be willing to engage with a GP on a regular basis.
