



You have been screened for coronavirus (COVID-19)

What happens next:

It may take a few days before you receive your test results. We appreciate your patience during this time.

You must now stay at home and self-quarantine while awaiting results:

- Self-quarantine means you must stay in your home at all times.
- You cannot leave your house for any reason unless it is an emergency, or you need medical help.
- You cannot have visitors to your home.

Please contact your GP to let them know you have been tested for COVID-19 with Monash Health Pathology.

If your result is negative, you will receive a text message to advise you.

You may resume activities once your symptoms subside, unless:

- you are a close contact of a known case, in which case you must still self-quarantine for the required 14 days,
- you have visited a public exposure site, in which case you should check the Department of Health and Human Services website for details of self-quarantine requirements, or,
- you have returned from New South Wales, in which case you should check the Department of Health and Human Services website for details of self-quarantine requirements.

If your result is positive, you will receive a phone call from the Department of Health and Human Services to advise you.
