You can book your vaccination appointment:

- **At our vaccination centres at Cranbourne Turf Club or Sandown Racecourse (Springvale)**
 - Use the new online booking system [here](#) or,
 - Call the Coronavirus Hotline on 1800 675 398
 - For bookings choose option 1, then option 1, then option 1
 - For an interpreter, choose option 0
 - Line is open 8.00am to 10.00pm, 7 days a week, please be patient as there is a great number of people wanting to be vaccinated
 - Quieter times to call are between 2.00pm to 4.00pm and after 7.30pm.
- **At a participating GP or community health service** through the Australian Government [Eligibility Checker](#).

While staff at the vaccination centres will do their best to accommodate walk-ins for those eligible for AstraZeneca, it is recommended you make a booking to avoid delays or disappointment. If you are eligible for Pfizer, bookings are essential. Please note we use the latest Government advice to administer the vaccine that is most appropriate for you. You cannot choose the vaccine type.
