

HiTH Sotrovimab Infusion Clinic

Sotrovimab is a pre-hospital monoclonal antibody treatment for COVID-19. Administered within the first 5 days of COVID-19 infection, Sotrovimab may reduce the chances of being admitted to hospital, or dying, by up to 85%.

Sotrovimab treatment is appropriate for:

- Positive COVID-19 PCR
- Symptoms of COVID-19 for ≤ 5 days
- Not on supplemental oxygen or dyspnoeic
- Aged ≥ 12 years

AND

- Are unvaccinated or partially vaccinated with the following risk factors:
 - Aged over 55 years
 - Diabetes requiring medication
 - Obesity $> 30\text{kg/m}^2$
 - Chronic Kidney Disease (NYHA class II or greater)
 - Chronic Heart Failure (eGFR < 60)
 - Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
 - Moderate to severe asthma (requiring inhaled steroids)
 - Pregnant with one or more of the above risk factors

OR

- Immunosuppressed – regardless of vaccination status & other risk factors.
