

## Monash Infusion Clinic

The Monash Health Infusion Clinic provides pre-hospital monoclonal antibody treatments for COVID-19.

If administered within the first 5 days of COVID-19 infection, Sotrovimab may reduce the chances of being admitted to hospital, or dying, by up to 85%.

If administered within the first 7 days of COVID-19 infection, Casirivimab plus Imdevimab may reduce the chances of being admitted to hospital, or dying, by up to 70%.

**Treatment with Sotrovimab or Casirivimab plus Imdevimab is appropriate for patients who have:**

- Positive COVID-19 PCR
- Symptoms of COVID-19 for  $\leq 7$  days
- Not on supplemental oxygen or dyspnoeic
- Aged  $\geq 12$  years and weigh  $\geq 40$  kg

**AND**

- Are unvaccinated or partially vaccinated with one or more of the following risk factors:
  - Aged over 50 years
  - Diabetes requiring medication
  - Obesity  $> 30\text{kg/m}^2$
  - Chronic Kidney Disease (NYHA class II or greater)
  - Chronic Liver Disease
  - Cardiovascular Disease (including hypertension)
  - Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
  - Moderate to severe asthma (requiring inhaled steroids)
  - Pregnant in second or third trimester with one or more of the above risk factors

**OR**

- Immunocompromised – regardless of vaccination status & other risk factors
