They will complete an assessment and respond to your concern.

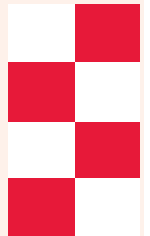


If you are still worried:

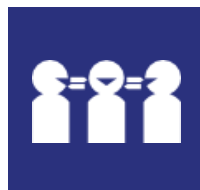
