Who we are: Registered nurses who can assist with the coordination of healthcare for people with disabilities. We work across the life span and have specialty in Paediatrics and working with the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

What Disability Liaison Officers can help with:

- Provide assistance and support to people with a disability to ensure adjustments related to their disability are made in their health care delivery.
- Provide advocacy and support to people with a disability accessing Monash Health service, including communicating with their health care professionals.
- Provide support with discharge planning from hospital and accessing communitybased services, including NDIS
- Support adults with a disability, their families and carers, to access COVID-19 screening, treatment and vaccination.
