

International Medical Graduate (IMG) Course



Course at a Glance

The IMG course is a one-day comprehensive clinical skills and simulation program designed by Monash Simulation in collaboration with Monash Doctors Education and the Monash Health International Medical Graduate Preparation Program (MiPreP). The course aims to equip participants with a structured approach to the assessment and management of deteriorating patients, specifically focusing on working within the Australian Healthcare System.

Course Topics

- Cultural differences and challenges working in the Australian Healthcare System
- Utilising a structured A – E approach for the assessment and management of acutely unwell patients
- Effective teamwork and communication strategies that can be used in the clinical environment
- Exploring ways to approach death & dying for patients and their loved ones

The course uses a blended educational approach, including interactive workshops, immersive simulation scenarios and facilitated discussions.

Who can Attend?

The course is aimed at IMGs already in Australia, who wish to enter the Australian medical workforce, taking part in the Monash Health International Medical Graduate Preparation (MiPreP) Program.
