

Acute Cardiovascular Emergencies



Course at a Glance

ACE is a one-day simulation course designed for medical and nursing staff who respond to acute cardiovascular emergencies. The course aims to improve knowledge and skills in assessing and managing patients with acute cardiac conditions. The course utilises a blended learning approach to maximise the opportunity for hands-on practice of clinical skills and to explore clinical decision making in immersive simulation scenarios.

Course Topics

Topics included in the course are:

- Vascular access and line insertion
- CPR, defibrillation and advanced cardiac life support
- External pacing

As well as the technical knowledge and skill required to manage complex cardiac events, ACE emphasises the importance of human factors skills; such as leadership, teamwork, and effective communication, which are known to contribute to improved patient safety.

Who can attend?

ACE is an interprofessional course, developed for:

- Medical registrars attending MET calls
- Medical staff with a minimum of 12 months experience in a critical care area (e.g. ED / ICU / Anaesthetics / Cardiology)
- Registered nurses with a minimum of 12 months experience in a critical care area (e.g. ED / ICU / Anaesthetics / Cardiology)
