Library research support services are available to Monash Health employees and students.

Turnaround times:

- Urgent requests relating to patient care will be prioritised and responded to as soon as possible.
- Research consultations and literature searches will be provided in 5-10 business days.
- Literature review reports will be provided in 10-15 business days.
