

Cardiothoracic ICU (CTICU) Introductory Course



Course at a Glance

The Cardiothoracic Intensive Care Unit (CTICU) Introductory Course is designed to equip Intensive Care Unit (ICU) registrars and nursing staff with the foundations of knowledge and skills in the initial management of the elective post-operative cardiothoracic surgical patient.

The program incorporates interactive discussions, workshops and simulation to explore the practical skills required for the care of the elective cardiothoracic surgical patient in the initial postoperative period.

CTICU Introductory Course also enables participants to explore and practice teamwork skills and behaviours vital for effective team performance such as leadership, followership, effective communication and shared situational awareness in cardiothoracic emergencies.

Who can attend?

The course is designed for the following groups:

ICU Registrars:

This is a must-attend program for any critical care trainee (Anaesthetics, ICU, General Medicine and Emergency Medicine) about to commence their rotation in a cardiothoracic ICU.

Critical Care Nurses:

ICU nurses who are caring for the postoperative cardiothoracic patient.

Prerequisites:

Participants need to be ALS competent and have completed the course pre-reading material.
