Course at a Glance

This is an inter-professional one day simulation course for Monash Health ward based Associate Nurse Unit Managers (ANUMs) and HMOs undertaking night-cover rotations.

Course Topics

- The course is specifically designed to equip ANUMs and HMOs with a structured approach to the initial assessment and management of acutely unwell patients. Participants will also have the opportunity to explore and practice various teamwork and communication skills that can enhance patient safety and assist with clinical decision making, task prioritisation and time utilisation during busy night shifts on the wards.
- The course uses a blended educational approach, including interactive workshops, team work and problem-solving activities, immersive simulation scenarios and facilitated discussions.
