Purpose of Acquiring Information

Organisation	Why we ask for this information
Department of Family, Fairness and Housing	If the DFFH are the legal guardian, we will seek permission from DFFH before significant medical intervention. We may provide information to DFFH such as copies of Paediatric letters.
Victorian Aboriginal Childcare Agency and Other Care Agencies	The HKK may contact Case Managers to arrange appointments and coordinate medical care. HKK may also attend Case Team meetings to speak about the child's health treatment.
School, Kindergarten and Day Care	HKK may speak to schools to arrange assessments, understand school performance, and social skills and contribute to arranging support in the classroom.
General Practitioner	After each HKK visit, a letter is emailed back to the child's GP. We may also plan and refer back to the GP for follow-up care.
Monash Health	If the child has visited Monash Health in the past or is using another Monash Health service, we may access those medical notes and speak to other healthcare providers within the organisation.
Legal Guardian	To know who the best contact person is and/or to send the appointment letters and SMS reminders.
NDIS Provider	HKK may need to speak to a NDIS Support Coordinator to provide assessments and plan future care for the kid.
