

BorrowBox

BorrowBox is an online resource that provides access to eBooks and eAudiobooks.

Connected Libraries members can borrow up to 10 eBooks and 10 eAudiobooks at a time. The loan period is 14 days.

Installing and signing in

1. Open the App Store on iPhone or Google Play Store on Android
2. Search and install 'BorrowBox'
3. Enter 'Connected Libraries' under the Library tab
4. Enter your library card number in the user ID space and your pin/password
5. Enter your email address to finish creating your account
6. Select 'Agree' to accept the terms and conditions

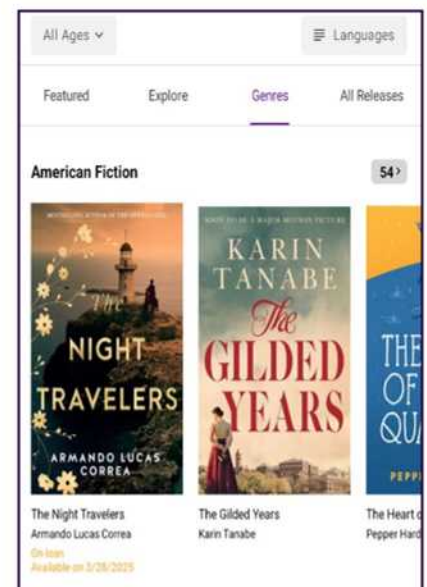
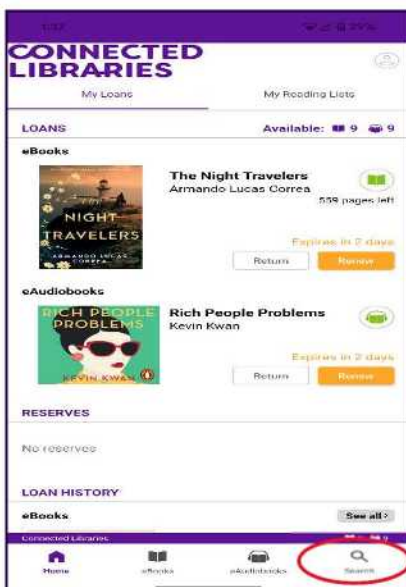

Searching

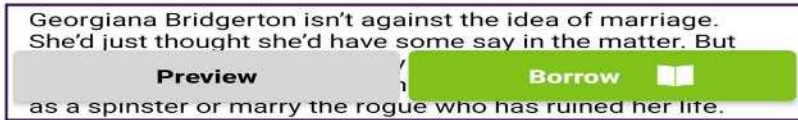
1. The home screen will show your account including your holds, loan history and current loans
2. Select the **magnifying glass** in the bottom right-hand corner to search for an author or title
3. Select **eBooks** or **eAudiobooks** to search for these specifically
 - a. Items without orange text are available to borrow straight away

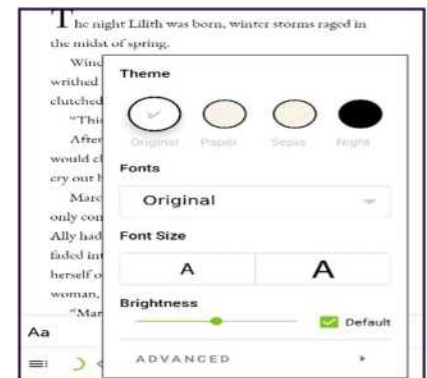
Borrowing

1. Tap on a book cover to select it
2. Tap the borrow button
3. Tap confirm and download
4. eAudiobooks need to be downloaded to listen to.
eBooks can be read online or downloaded for offline use



Reading an eBook

1. Swipe your finger across the screen to turn the page
2. The Aa icon will show more settings including:
 - a. Size of text
 - b. Background colour (Theme)
 - c. Font
 - d. Brightness



Listening to an eAudiobook

When reading an eAudiobook, the controls are at the bottom on screen.
From left to right they are:

1. Go back 30 seconds
2. Skip to previous track
3. Play/pause button
4. Skip to next track
5. Move forward 30 seconds
6. Playback speed
7. Sleep timer to stop book playing after a designated time
