S.O.U.P is a one-day comprehensive clinical skills and simulation program designed to equip participants with a structured approach to assess and manage deteriorating patients on the ward.

Course topics

- Use of a structured approach to assess and manage unwell patients.
- Latest evidence about clinical deterioration in ward-based areas.
- Effective communication strategies and behaviours that aid teamwork coordination and clinical decision making.
- The course includes interactive lectures and video analysis, team work and problem-solving activities, practice of clinical skills during workshops, immersive simulation scenarios and facilitated discussions.
